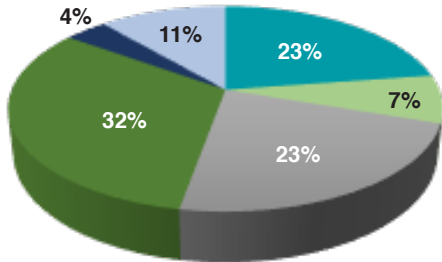

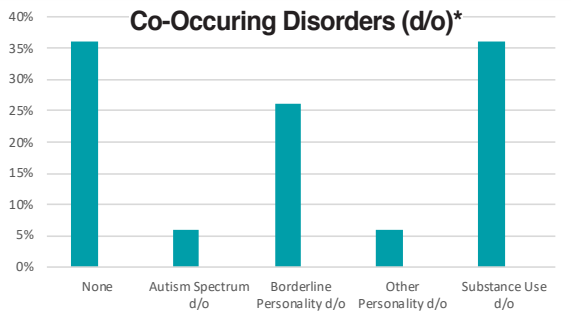
## Primary Diagnosis\*

\*Nearly 50% of residents were also diagnosed with co-occurring personality or substance abuse disorders

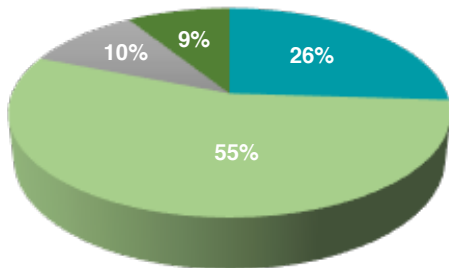
## Co-Occurring Disorders (d/o)\*



■ % of Total Residential Residents

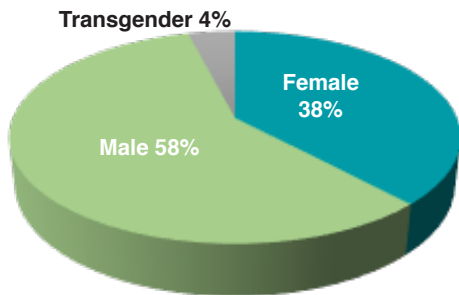

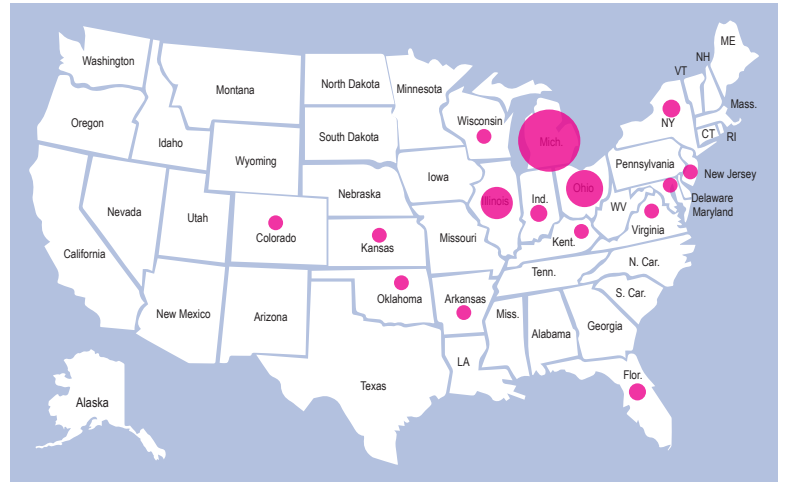

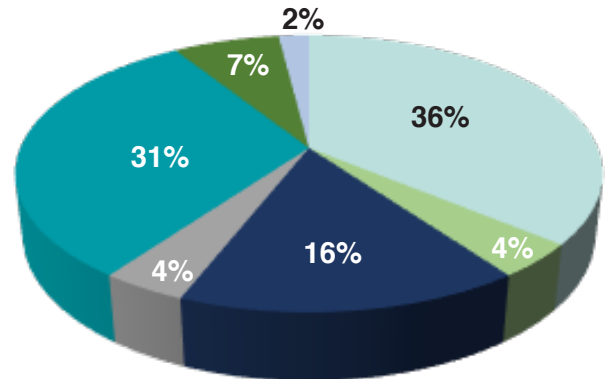

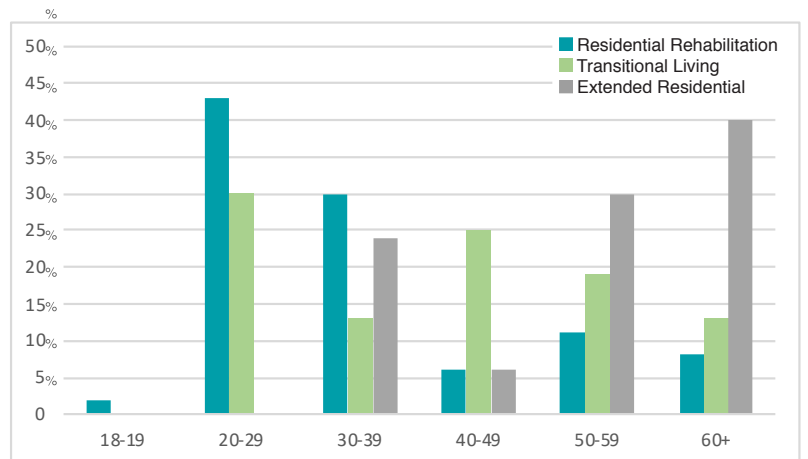

## Age by Program

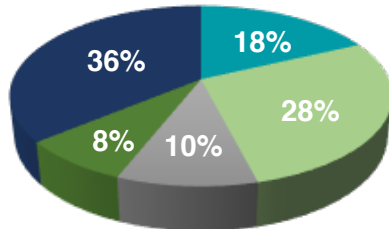

### Average Length of Stay

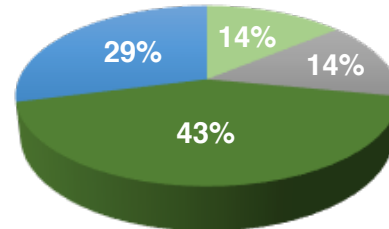
#### Residential Rehabilitation Program

Average 264 Days



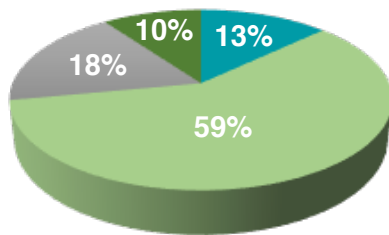
#### Transitional Living Program

Average 365 Days

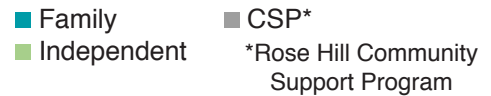
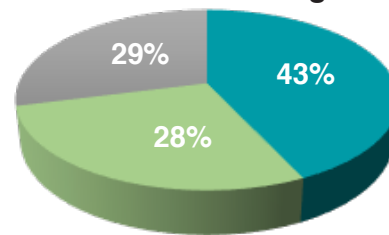

### OUTCOME MEASURES

Each year, the success of Rose Hill Centers' treatment program can be seen in the lives of the residents who return to their families and communities. We have verified this through outcomes measures and assessments which have consistently shown an improvement in our residents' functioning and a decrease in psychiatric symptoms. Rose Hill utilizes the Daily Living Activities-20 (DLA-20), a research-based outcomes measurement tool which measures twenty items of functionality. And a 3-year post discharge study using the BASIS-24 reveals enduring relief from psychiatric symptoms.
